## PROGRAMS


Founded in 1945, San Diego Youth Symphony and Conservatory (SDYS) serves as a catalyst for investing in the future of young San Diegans through the study and performance of music. SDYS offers “cradle-to-college” programming for thousands of young people from diverse backgrounds and provides both need-based assistance and merit scholarships to ensure every student’s success.

Our flagship ENSEMBLE program, in historic Balboa Park, hosts hundreds of students in 14 year-round ensembles. Each summer, the International Youth Symphony, offered in partnership with Rotary International Youth Exchange, brings dozens of international students to San Diego for a summer of learning and cultural exchange.



The CONSERVATORY TRACK, launching officially in 2021, features expanded learning and enrichment opportunities for young people interested in pursuing intensive musical experiences, including chamber music, music theory, composition, second instrument camps, summer opportunities, and more. Programs take place both in Balboa Park and as part of Community Engagement partnerships.

Our EARLY CHILDHOOD program, **Chimes** (Childhood Introduction to Music Education, with Smiles), offers classes for families in Balboa Park, in preschools and TK classrooms, and with other educational partners throughout San Diego County.



SDYS COMMUNITY PROGRAMS partner with schools, community organizations, and school districts across the region to restore or enhance music education in local schools. Recognized nationally, the **Opus Project** is a model for how music education can be a vehicle for both community engagement and public/private partnerships.

# A YEAR IN REVIEW

SDYS began its 2019-20 season with an air of anticipation. The Balboa Park Ensemble program enrolled its largest class in recent history and included over 100 students from its Community Programs, including five students in SDYS' pre-professional level, Ovation. SDYS Community Programs continued their work both in Chula Vista Elementary School District and in San Diego Unified through work in the City Heights neighborhood. Lastly, SDYS' early childhood programs expanded to serve an ever-growing community of area families.

Of course, in March, the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic was felt in Balboa Park and across the nation. SDYS was able to quickly shift all programming online and continued virtual programming for the remainder of our fiscal year. SDYS hosted its first virtual gala and successfully netted more funds than at our previous in-person event. Like everyone else, SDYS has adapted to the "new normal" of the pandemic and is working diligently to continue to offer the highest quality programming and services to our families. We are using the most innovative technological solutions to ensure that our students, families, audiences, stakeholders, and community partners stay connected, engaged and inspired.

SDYS is working hard to bring music education to as many partner schools as possible. We are actively seeking to replicate the nationally recognized success of the Community Opus Project with new partners in San Diego and to expand our scholarship and assistance programs to ensure that any young person who wants to participate in SDYS programs has the chance to do so. SDYS continues to work with the homeschool community through the Soaring Minds Education program and is adding new partnerships with charter schools in the Lincoln Park neighborhood and in San Diego Unified. Despite the impact of Covid-19, we are actively planning to pilot new programming.

As we look ahead to our 75th anniversary season, there are changes to our original plans to be sure. However, we will continue to celebrate the resilience of this historic organization. We will open our new administrative offices in Liberty Station. We will expand our programs and curriculum to give SDYS families greater breadth and intensity in programming. We will launch new programs and a summer session. We will inaugurate programs with new community partners. In short, we will endure and we will always maintain our focus on young people and building the pathways that put them on the road to success.



- Total operating revenue of **\$1,755,079**


Prior to the onset of the Covid-19 pandemic, SDYS was poised to have one of its strongest financial performances in several years. After March, SDYS instituted a series of cost-cutting measures while maintaining all programming, ending the year with a loss of roughly \$6,000 or less than 1% of operating revenue.

As we look to the future, SDYS will maintain a cautious fiscal outlook as we anticipate the impact of the pandemic to last through 2021-22. Our goals for the future are to provide outstanding programming, both virtual and in-person, to educate and entertain audiences across San Diego, to provide on-going employment for our teams, and to be a catalyst for community healing and growth through music education.


