Where is the camp located?

Camp activities will feature a mix of indoor and outdoor activities, held in our **Early Childhood Music Studio** in **Liberty Station** (2820 Roosevelt Rd., 2nd floor, San Diego, **CA 92106)** and a nearby grassy area just outside the building. Camper check-in and
check-out will take place inside the studio.

What is the cost of camp?

The tuition for the full week of camp is \$350 per camper.
